



Ukraine War Relief Program – 2025 Report


HUMANITARIAN RELIEF IMPACT



In response to the ongoing crisis, comprehensive support was provided to families severely impacted by the war. Assistance efforts included distributing food packages containing essential groceries, providing hot meals to those in need, and supplying hygiene items and critical medicines.



Beyond material aid, recipients also received emotional and spiritual support. Dedicated volunteers and support teams offered a listening ear and guidance to individuals striving for stability amid the uncertainties of war, fostering a sense of hope and resilience in the community.



Through these combined initiatives, approximately 10,000 internally displaced persons (IDPs) and refugees benefited from food assistance and psychosocial care.

HOPE CENTRE: MEDICAL CARE AND REHABILITATION SUPPORT



The Hope Centre Program also funded medical examinations, injury care, chronic condition treatment, and trauma support, delivering direct medical aid to 60 war-affected families from areas that have been liberated from Russian occupation.



HOPE CENTRE: MEDICAL CARE AND REHABILITATION SUPPORT

To address the urgent medical needs of individuals affected by the war, substantial resources were allocated to support struggling healthcare facilities in the region.



We donated over \$20,000 worth of medical equipment and essential medicines to the Vinnytsia Rehabilitation Clinic, a 350-bed facility, along with other hospitals across the Vinnytsia Region and frontline cities.



Children & Youth Recovery Programs



Children and youth affected by the war received spiritual education, emotional support, and mentorship, helping them progress emotionally and spiritually despite difficult circumstances.

A variety of activities were organized, including summer camps, weekend events, and city-wide outreaches.



In total, 350 children and youth participated in these programs, which provided them with safety, joy, and hope during a difficult time.

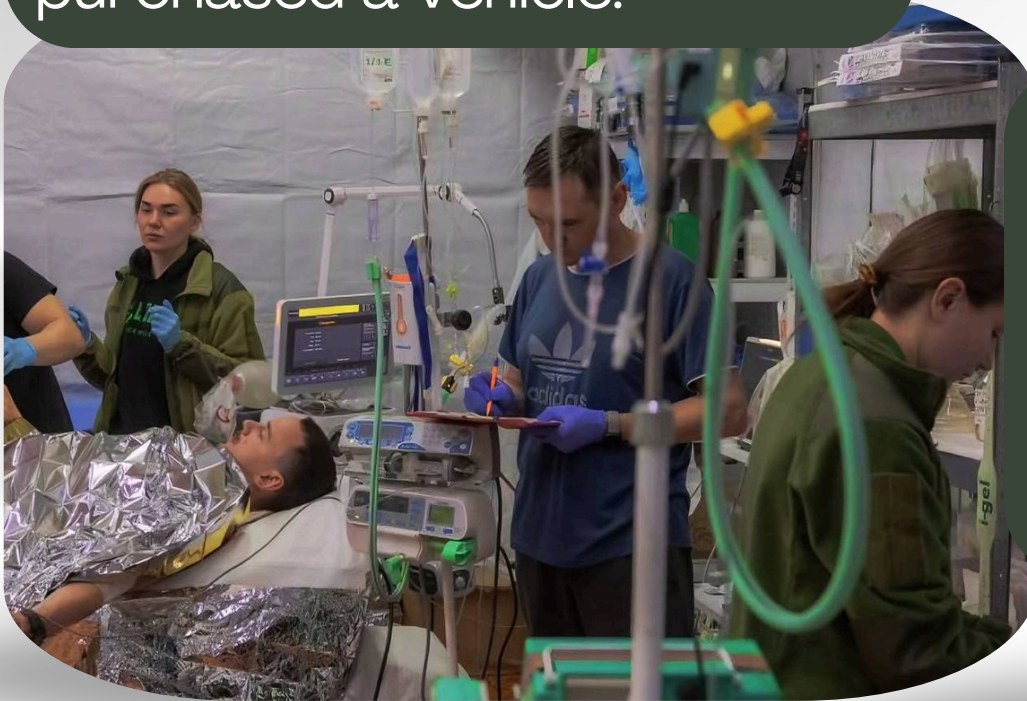


Frontline Ministry & Chaplain Support



Frontline volunteers, evangelists, and displaced pastors continued their dedicated service in extremely hazardous environments.

To further support the expansion of chaplaincy outreach into frontline cities and other high-risk regions, we covered the cost of fuel for their transportation and purchased a vehicle.



These resources enabled chaplains to reach more individuals affected by the conflict, providing essential support and spiritual care in areas where it was urgently needed.

Gospel Outreach & Discipleship



This year, we continued to share the gospel message to IDPs and refugees impacted by war, offering them hope and spiritual support during challenging times.

Alongside major gospel events, we held weekly Bible studies and discipleship groups through the Alpha Course Evangelistic Programme.



These meetings supported participants' spiritual growth and fostered meaningful community connections. The Gospel message was shared with over 9,000 IDPs. More than 500 IDPs and refugees affected by the war participated in weekly Bible studies and other discipleship programmes.



Hope Centre Building Project Update

Construction of the Hope Centre faced several significant challenges throughout the year. Limited financial resources constrained the project's ability to maintain consistent momentum. At the same time, severe inflation drove up the costs of essential building materials such as concrete, steel, and lumber, as well as labor rates.



The nationwide military draft created an acute shortage of skilled tradespeople—including electricians, plumbers, and carpenters—making it challenging to staff critical phases of construction. Additionally, frequent and unpredictable power outages disrupted work schedules and delayed the operation of essential equipment.

Despite these formidable obstacles, the project achieved significant milestones

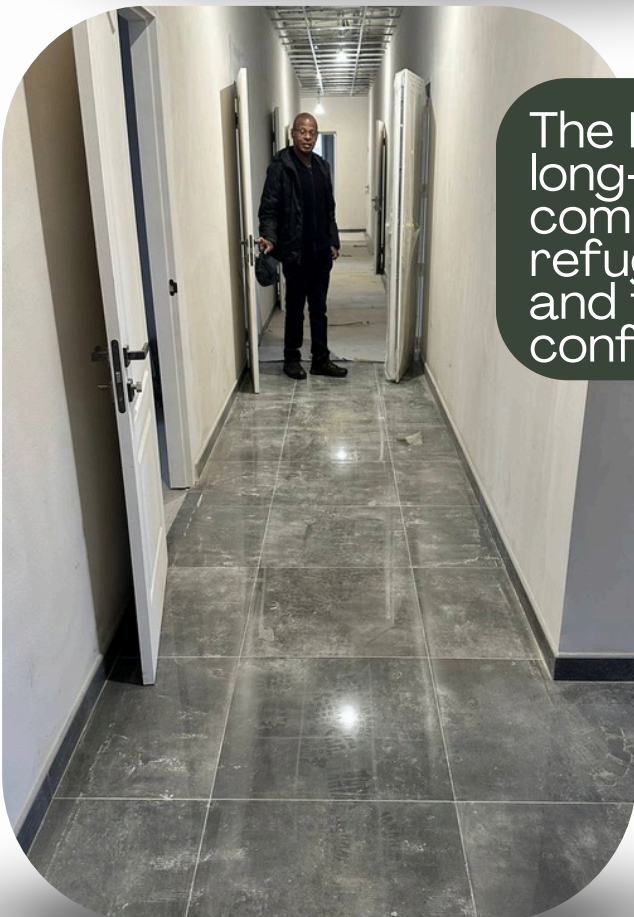


The structural framework was completed and reinforced, interior walls were erected and prepared for finishing, and essential systems—including electrical wiring, plumbing infrastructure, and HVAC installations—were successfully integrated into the building.

The facility is now steadily advancing toward completion

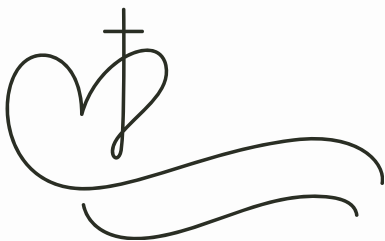
